***** With the passage of H.B. 2075 (2011) modifying West Virginia Code §8-13-4, all municipalities have the authority to create an annual general municipal business license for multiple purposes.

***** With the passage of H.B. 2723 (2009) modifying West Virginia Code §8-13-13, all municipalities have the authority to file a lien on property within city limits for unpaid and delinquent fire, police, or street fires.

***** With the passage of H.B. 4034 (2010) creating West Virginia Code §8-12-16c, all municipalities have the authority to establish a vacant building registration program and file liens on property for unpaid and delinquent vacant building registration fees.
