New Business

The Board received and reviewed correspondence from the Harrison County Commission dated March 3, 2009. After discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Jon Amores that a reply to the Harrison County Commission convey the following: 1) the Board will not speculate upon the intent of the West Virginia Legislature as regards home rule; 2) the Board will not give legal opinions on home rule projects; 3) the members issue an invitation to the Harrison County Commission to meet with them at a future meeting; and, 4) reiterate the Board's desire for Bridgeport, Clarksburg and the Harrison County Commission to work together resolving related matters. The motion was seconded by Mr. Brian Jones and unanimously carried.

Lastly, it was noted that several of the home rule cities have expressed an interest in amending their current home rule plans and that these cities have been advised to follow the steps of their original home rule submission.

Adjournment

With no further business, a motion was made by Mr. Jon Amores to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 8:15 a.m.
