Beginning July 1, 2017, the B&O Tax rate for retail was reduced from .0015 to .005. The reduced rate has resulted in reduced revenues of \$126,067.60 since July 1, 2017.								
The net revenue gain because of the 1% tax is \$610,404.98.
